

COVID-10 POST VACCINATION GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOLS

(January 29, 2021)

In a two-shot series (Pfizer, Moderna) this guidance applies to both shots



Individual has sensitivity, pain, redness or swelling around the vaccination site, but no other symptoms

Follow usual protocols for vaccine-related side effects. Individual may return to school.

Individual has symptoms that may be caused by the vaccine:

Fever
Fatigue
Headache
Chills
Muscle or joint pain/ache

Individual should stay home.

If symptoms resolve within 48 hours, the individual may return to work when symptom free.

If symptoms persist beyond 48 hours, individual should get tested for COVID-19 and follow established protocols for faculty, staff or students who show symptoms of COVID-19 infection.

Individual has symptoms unlikely to be caused by the vaccine:

Cough
Shortness of Breath
Runny Nose
Sore Throat Loss of taste or smell

Follow established protocols for faculty, staff or students who show symptoms of a COVID-19 infection.

It's not possible to get a positive COVID-19 test result, nor the COVID-19 illness from the vaccine. It takes a few weeks for your body to become immune to COVID-19, and it's possible to be exposed to and develop COVID-19 during this time
